Some 9,000 students from 98 countries and regions study in Fukuoka Prefecture – the third highest number in Japan after Tokyo and Osaka.

Many excellent universities

Fukuoka is home to 38 universities (including 10 for science and technology), 20 junior colleges and 3 specialized vocational schools, where some 130,000 students currently study.

Living expenses lower than national average

Monthly living expenses (including academic fees) for an international student in Fukuoka are lower than the national average. Compared with Tokyo, rent is roughly halved and living costs can be cut down by 25%.
